

Tips for Packing Your Starter Kit Bag

Here are a few suggestions you might want to try, or modify, when packing out your Starter Kit Bags for classes.

You'll first want to click on [Packing Checklist](#) to help you determine what items you may need for a class.

Once you've gathered all of your products and tools for the class, you might consider packing your samplers and products in Quick Zip bags to keep things organized.



Also, to get a head-start on preparing for your class, you might consider pre-packing your Face Cases with a disposable tray. Once the Face Case is back in its Quick Zip bag, you might want to fill each bag with the items each guest may use at the class such as a Facial Cloth, Customer Profile (folded), Classic Looks Card, applicators or a Sales Ticket to name a few.



Then, as you start packing your Starter Kit bag, you may want to begin by placing your packed-out Quick Zip bags in first. You may try shifting those around to get the best fit! Lastly, consider storing literature such as Beauty Books and your datebook in the side pocket of your Starter Kit Bag. Another good way to transport literature is in your On-The-Go Tote.



And, if you plan to take a Travel Roll-Up Bag filled with the sets illustrated in the Beauty Book, you might consider propping it on top of the Starter Kit bag as a more convenient way to carry both pieces.



But of course, how you choose to pack your Starter Kit bag is really up to you. We know that everyone has her own individual way of preparing for a class, and we hope this gave you a few ideas.
